

**Agile Canines June Agility Seminar 2009!!  
Dana Pike and Stacy Peardot-Goudy

**Tuesday and Wednesday will be an Advanced Handling Seminar  
Thursday will be an Intermediate Handling Seminar  
Location Twin Cities Metro Area**

**Advanced Handling Seminar on Tuesday and Wednesday** – this is open to all dogs and handlers who are competing at the Excellent/Elite/Masters level. There will be two groups and each group will work with each instructor for two half-day sessions over the two days. Groups will be divided by level and experience of dog and handler to the best of our ability and based on information provided by the handler. A detailed questionnaire will be sent to registered participants.

Cost will be \$350 for a working spot for the two days if paid in **full** by March 1<sup>st</sup>. If paid in full after March 1<sup>st</sup> the fee is \$400. Final payment is due May 1<sup>st</sup>. Auditing spots will be \$100 for two days.

**Intermediate Handling Seminar on Thursday** – this is open to dogs and handlers currently competing in Novice or Open levels of agility. Groups will be divided by level and experience of dog and handler to the best of our ability and based on information provided by the handler. A detailed questionnaire will be sent to registered participants.

Cost will be \$175 for a working spot for one day if paid in **full** by March 1<sup>st</sup>. If paid in full after March 1<sup>st</sup> the fee is \$200. Auditing spots will be \$50 for one day.

**What is included:**

Seminar fee includes lunch and morning and afternoon snacks and beverages. Hotel information and directions will be sent upon request. The seminars will start promptly at 8am each day and end by 5:30 pm each day. There is ample crating space indoors.

**Special Notes:**

There will be a USDAA trial the weekend before the seminar and an AKC trial the weekend after the trial at the same location.

**Stacy Peardot-Goudy**

Stacy is an agility veteran whose dogs have earned the entire alphabet soup of agility titles (MACH2, O-NATCH x 2, ADCH x 7, MX, MXJ, etc.). Stacy has qualified for the USDAA Grand Prix of Dog Agility the last 13 years in a row, Stacy and Secret represented the US at the IFCS World Championships in 2002 and 2004. In 2006 Stacy and Able represented the US at the IFCS World Championships. In 2002 she won the individual gold and led the team to 1st place. Stacy started in agility with her Boxers in 1989 and in 2007 is competing with Rumor, Maze, Able and youngsters Wally and Veruca. Stacy has trained, shown, and, titled dogs from 4 different groups including Aussies, Border Collies, Jack Russell Terriers, Boxers, and, a German Wirehaired Pointer. If you want to work a second dog at the seminar you must register for the lowest level of the dogs you plan to bring in order to not hold up an advanced group by working a less experienced dog on an exercise.

Your initial deposit -- \$100 for participants, \$50 for auditors (for two days) \$25 for auditors (for one day)- is refundable ONLY if and when your spot in the seminar can be filled.
